Parish development; the Diocesan Council of Priests met this past week to consider the proposal to close St Bernadette's. They and Bishop Patrick took time to look over all the results of the consultation process, discuss the matter at some length and question Fr Joe about the proposal. **They unanimously approved the proposal to close St Bernadette's.** The process now goes to the formalities of approval of the Diocesan Trustees and College of Consultors and Bishop Patrick issuing a decree of closure. Soon we will have a date set for closure which will give us enough time to put in place plans for the future. The Council commended the Parish Pastoral Council for the manner in which the consultation process had been carried out – for the transparency and honesty of the consultation.
