**Parish development;** we are starting to move forward with the plans to improve our facilities in the parish. At the moment, the closure of St Bernadette's and finding a 'new home' in Sneinton for our 9am Mass is the focus, but we will also be dealing with the old church building in the next few weeks and months. We will not have bulldozers moving in anywhere tomorrow! These things take time to bring to a conclusion and we will take a staged approach to any developments. The old church is an expensive building to run and to leave it empty for any length of time would be unwise – so we will come back to the parish in the next few months with a plan of how to deal with it. We will also bring forward the provision of toilet facilities etc at the Church. **Whilst the parish is relatively healthy in a financial sense, we need to make a concerted effort to build up a fund to meet some of the costs of development.** To this end, we will be handing out envelopes for parish development in advance of a **second collection next weekend, 20<sup>th</sup> /21<sup>st</sup> August.** We will have a few of these in the year to help boost the reserves and enable us to make a start with some aspects of the plans. If you haven't taken one of the little yellow development fund envelopes, then please do so and Gift Aid your contribution if you can.

**Confirmation:** We have a date for Bishop Patrick to visit for Confirmation; Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2017. Because of the maturity required for the Sacrament and to have a number for Confirmation that is able to fit in the church, those who will be in Year 9 or above in September 2017 will be invited to come forward to be Confirmed. Bishop Patrick has agreed that he will celebrate Confirmation for us every two years, rather than every three, so after 2017, we will be looking at September 2019. Early in 2017 there will be a meeting for all parents of young people who wish to be Confirmed in 2017. As already established and advertised, the expectation for any young person who wishes to be Confirmed is that they will have attended at least 8 of the previous 10 CatholicTwentyFourSeven meetings which happen every month on a Monday evening. Early in 2017, the young people will be invited to express their desire to be Confirmed. The remaining dates for CatholicTwentyFourSeven this year are 26<sup>th</sup> September, 24<sup>th</sup> October, 28<sup>th</sup> November, & 19<sup>th</sup> December.

**Baptism Preparation;** the next course for parents wanting their children baptised takes place over two evenings; Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> September and Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October, both evenings 7 – 8 in the Parish Centre. To enrol on the preparation, please complete one of the Sacrament of Baptism leaflets at the back of Church and return it to Fr Joe.

**Apostleship of the Sea;** we have received a letter of thanks for holding the recent Sea Sunday Appeal, it reads "We are very grateful indeed to you and your parishioners for their financial gift along with their supporting prayers. Would you please convey our sincere thanks to them. Your support goes a long way to helping us continue our good work in caring pastorally for the seafarer who come to our shores. The plight for some of these good people can really be heart breaking. Loneliness is a very big factor as they miss out on family life and children miss seeing their parent for so many months at a time. Collecting unwanted rosaries, medals, prayer cards etc., and sending them to a Port Chaplain is another way parishes help. May God continue to bless you and your parish abundantly for giving from the heart."

**Funeral arrangements;** when a loved one dies, it can often be very difficult for family members to make the funeral arrangements if no instructions or wishes have been left behind by the deceased. To help that process, you can take one of the sheets from the back of church 'Instructions for my funeral', complete it as best you can and leave copies with your next of kin, priest and even chosen funeral director. This is not in anticipation of impending death! It is a really simple way of thinking now about what arrangements you might like to be made. If you need any help filling out the form, let Fr Joe know and he can sit with you and take you through it. If you leave a copy with the parish, it is kept confidential and can be amended by you at any time.

**Friday morning Mass;** this has traditionally been at 9.15 to allow for the school to come over to join us. There is no need for this time change in the future, so please note that from this week, all morning Masses will be at 9.00 unless otherwise stated. Because of the pressure in schools on teaching time, we will be providing lots of other opportunities for the parish and school to join together for Mass rather than this weekly slot.
