**Fr Joe will be away on retreat** 3 – 7<sup>th</sup> October. Our seminarian, Joe will be around that week, as will Ann the Parish Secretary.

**New home in Sneinton;** the opportunity is offered on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> October to have a look at three different places where we might be able to have Mass on Sunday morning in Sneinton when St Bernadette's closes. If you are interested in coming to have a look and help make a decision about which one suits us best, meet at Sneinton Hermitage Community Centre (Sneinton Boulevard) at 1.00, we will then go to St Christopher's on Colwick Road at 1.30 and then to The Greenway Centre on Trent Lane at 2.15 ish. It is easy to walk between all three. Parking at the first venue is best either on Sneinton Boulevard itself or on Thurgaton Street. Alternatively, there is parking on Trent Lane.

**Cafod envelopes** will be given out this weekend in preparation for Family Fast Day on Friday 7<sup>th</sup>. Why not, as a family, just have soup, a roll and water on the Friday evening and each person give a bit of their wage for the week or pocket money to Cafod? We will collect the envelopes back in next weekend.

**Confirmation:** Bishop Patrick will visit for Confirmation; Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2017. **Because of the maturity required for the Sacrament and to have a number for Confirmation that is able to fit in the church, those who will be in Year 9 or above in September 2017 will be invited to come forward to be Confirmed.** Bishop Patrick will celebrate Confirmation for us every two years, rather than every three. The expectation for any young person who wishes to be Confirmed is that they will have attended at least 8 of the previous 10 CatholicTwentyFourSeven meetings which happen every month on a Monday evening. The remaining dates for CatholicTwentyFourSeven this year are 26<sup>th</sup> September, 24<sup>th</sup> October, 28<sup>th</sup> November, & 19<sup>th</sup> December.

**Parish Safeguarding;** we all have a responsibility to work safely and to keep safe children and vulnerable adults in our parish, all parishes in the diocese have to go through the process of renewal of DBS (CRB) checks of everyone who works with children or vulnerable adults. This is now a much easier process than before and can be done in minutes on-line if you have internet access. **If you have previously had a CRB through the parish – please collect a letter from the sacristy which explains the renewal process. If you have recently started working in this area in the parish, there is a letter for you too – they are all in a folder in alphabetical order.** If you previously had a CRB check through the parish and there isn't a letter – speak to Fr Joe. It might be that you don't need one anymore.
