First Holy Communion preparation; Thursday 6th May, 6 – 7 in the Parish Centre. Parents' meeting (children also coming along to work with the catechists) Thursday 11th May, 6.00 in Sacred Heart Church, we will celebrate a commentary Mass – during which we stop a few times and talk through with the children what a particular part of the Mass means. All parents and children on the programme are encouraged to come along and anyone in the parish who wants to attend is very welcome.

Date for your diaries; Italian night – Tuesday 30th May at St Christopher's Parish Hall, Trent Lane, Sneinton. This is the first joint social activity between our congregation and the people at St Christopher's. Fine wines, good food a lovely opportunity to socialise as a Christian community in the area and build our relations. Tickets will be available next week.

Parking; we have received a couple of complaints about parking outside Sacred Heart Church – particularly on Saturday evening. It appears that a few people are choosing to park on the main road even when there are plenty of spaces available in the car park. This then restricts the view of people exiting the car park – they are not able to see up the hill for traffic approaching. Please park in the car park in the first instance, only using the main road when the car park is full. If you need level access into the church, then park behind the church and walk along past the parish centre and garage – there are no steps or inclines to negotiate. The last thing we want is for complaints to continue and action to be taken.

Baptism preparation; our next course for parents is taking place on Wednesday 24th May and Wednesday 7th June, both evenings 7 – 8 and ideally both parents should attend both evenings. If you want to register on the course, take a form from the back of church and return it completed to Fr Joe.

Bishop Patrick will be leading a Blessed Sacrament Procession in honour of The Venerable Mary Potter through the streets of Nottm. on **Sunday 21st May at 2:30pm**. Starting at St Mary's Church, Goodliffe St, Hyson Green (where Mary Potter founded the Little Company of Mary) and proceeding to the Cathedral (where she is buried) where Benediction will be given by Bishop Patrick at around 4.30pm. All are most welcome. (Though will need to be able to walk 1.5 miles. If not you may prefer to meet the Procession at the Cathedral).
