**St Bernadette's.** Contracts of sale have been signed and exchanged, and we will formally vacate the building on 26<sup>th</sup> May when the sale will go through. It has been sold to the Ahmadiyya Muslim Association for use as a community centre and place of worship. They have been meeting in the Bakersfield Community Centre for many years but have been looking for their own buildings in the Sneinton area. It is great that the building will be used by a local community group and as a place of worship too, rather than just going to a business or for commercial use. The local representatives of the buyers and the local faith leaders have been very respectful of our past use of the building and once they have refurbished the building, will be glad to host a parish visit. More information about them can be found at their national website; [www.loveforallthatredfornone.org](http://www.loveforallthatredfornone.org). **The building was on the market for £400,000 and we accepted the offer of £360,000. This money will go a long way towards us realising the development plans for the parish.**

**Moving Out** – there is a little bit of work to do to get rid of the last few items now left in St Bernadette's. Everything left there now is of little or no value and needs to be disposed of. **IF YOU CAN HELP** – we will be getting a skip on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> and Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May. It should only take a few of us a few hours to clear out. Let Fr Joe know if you can lend a hand.

**Next Sunday for the 10.30 Mass**, we will be led in our liturgy by members of the Chaplaincy Team in Sacred Heart School.

**CatholicTwentyFourSeven** – our next meeting for young people of secondary school age is on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup>, 7 – 9 in the Parish Centre.

**Walsingham Coach** – this has now been booked and will cost £10 for an adult and £5 for a child. It will depart from Sacred Heart on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> June at 8am sharp, returning that evening around 8pm. If you want a seat on the coach for this lovely diocesan pilgrimage, then sign up. Please put your money for the trip in an envelope marked 'Walsingham' and hand it in to the sacristy or parish office.

**Parish Census;** if you have not in the past year completed a Parish Registration Form (available at the back of Church) **PLEASE DO SO IN THE NEXT WEEK OR SO.** There are still lots of people who assume that their contact details such as address, phone number etc are known. It is frustrating when people leave a message at the presbytery asking for a visit, but leave no phone number or address ..... and they do not appear in parish records!

**This weekend**, we will have a basket at the back of church as we leave to contribute to a leaving collection for Joe McCay, to support him a little bit before he is able to begin work or study after finishing his placement with us.

**Italian Night** – Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> May, 7pm at St Christopher's Church Hall in Sneinton. Tickets available now - £3 an adult, £2 for children. Includes two course meal, first drink and great company! This is the first joint social activity between our congregation and the people at St Christopher's - a lovely opportunity to socialise as a Christian community in the area and build our relations.

**Baptism preparation;** our next course for parents is taking place on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May and Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June, both evenings 7 – 8 and ideally both parents should attend both evenings. If you want to register on the course, take a form from the back of church and return it completed to Fr Joe.

**3 Peaks Challenge;** Fr Joe is climbing Ben Nevis, Scafell Pike and Snowdon over three days in late June to raise money for the Briars, our youth centre. **Blessed Sacrament Procession:** Bishop Patrick will be leading a Blessed Sacrament Procession in honour of The Venerable Mary Potter through the streets of Nottm. on **Sunday 21st May at 2:30pm.** Starting at St Mary's Church, Goodliffe St, Hyson Green and proceeding to the Cathedral where Benediction will be given by Bishop Patrick at around 4.30pm. All welcome. (Though will need to be able to walk 1.5 miles. If not you may prefer to meet the Procession at the Cathedral).

**Rotas:** Ann Oliphant is in the process of putting together the new rotas for Reading, Welcoming, Counting, Cleaning and Eucharistic Ministry. Please let Ann know if wish to join any of these valuable teams by emailing the Parish office. Thank you.

**Rosary;** The month of May is traditionally devoted to Mary, the mother of Our Lord. Our Wednesday morning Rosary sessions start at 8.40. Please add your intentions to the list at the back of the church and come along to say the rosary if you have twenty minutes to spare.
