General is deputy to the Bishop and we have always had two in our diocese. Both Mgr Tom McGovern and Fr John Guest are retiring from the role and are being replaced by Fr Joe and Fr Eddy Jarosz both of whom were born in Sacred Heart Parish, so we are clearly now the heart of the diocese! Interested in learning more about the Catholic faith?

Maybe enquire a bit about becoming a Catholic? We will be starting a group in September for adults who are interested in delving into the Catholic faith, maybe exploring the possibility of being either baptised or received into the Catholic Church. If you think you might be interested – speak to Fr Joe. Every year about 200 adults in our diocese explore their faith and then become members of the Catholic Church – you could be one of them!

Marriage in the Catholic Church; the Church takes preparation for the commitment to marriage very seriously and wants to ensure that couples enter into this commitment well prepared. For this reason, if anyone wants to get married in the Catholic Church, at least 8 months notice is required to the church where you live. Even if getting married elsewhere, all preparation and paperwork for the marriage can only take place in the church of residence.
