He will share his experiences and a collection will be taken up to support the work of the Columbans.

Sick and Retired Priest's Fund.

Thank you for your very generous collection last weekend for the Sick & Retired Priest's Fund. The total was an amazing £941.90. Over the past 5 years, we have raised over £61,000 for this fund which goes to support priests in their illness or retirement – a fantastic effort.

No Heating!! On the weekends of 27th/28th January and 3rd/4th February, there will be no heating in Sacred Heart church – this is due to the work to move the gas supply and demolish the garage to make way for the toilet and St Bernadette's room extension to the side of the church. **SO** – the Saturday evening Mass will take place as normal at 6.30 – but at **St Paul's**, just down Carlton Hill. There is a bit of parking there, but if you are able, then for these two weekends, park in our own car park and take the 3 minute walk down the hill. On Sunday morning on each weekend, we will have Mass as normal at 8.45 at St Christopher's in Sneinton, but there will **NOT be a 10.30 Mass.** This arrangement is only for two weekends – and if you haven't been down to Mass at St Christopher's – now is your chance to come and see how it is working. Alternatively, it is a chance to come together as a larger congregation at St Paul's on the Saturday evening. Thank you to Rev Wendy and the congregation at St Paul's for letting us borrow the church. During the heating-less weeks, weekday Mass/services will be in the small meeting room in the Parish Centre. Please let any friends or relatives know of these changes if they are not at Mass this weekend. Thank you.

Baptism preparation; in 2018, we will be doing this jointly with Our Lady & St Edwards. The first course of 2018 will be over two evenings; Wednesday 24th January at Sacred Heart and 7th February at Our Lady & St Edwards. Both evenings are 7 – 8.30 and both parents should attend both evenings. If you want to enrol on the preparation, take one of the forms from the back of church and return it to Fr Joe.

Next weekend; 6.30 Mass is at St Paul's on Carlton Hill. 8.45 Sunday morning is at St Christopher's as usual BUT there is NO SUNDAY MORNING 10.30 MASS. If you come to 6.30 Saturday evening Mass, there is limited parking at St Paul's, so please leave that for those who have limited mobility. If you are able, please park at Sacred Heart as usual then take the 3 minute walk down the hill.

Children's liturgy; On the weekends of 28th January and 4th February The Children's Liturgy will take place during the Saturday 6.30 Mass at St Paul's Church.

Catholic TwentyFourSeven – we next meet on Monday 29th January, 7 – 9 in the Parish Centre. All young people of secondary school age are welcome to come along. These evenings are instead of us having a traditional Confirmation programme of a few evenings preparation for the Confirmation Mass, then nothing else for young people. If you want to be confirmed in late 2019, then you will have had to come along to at least 8 out of the previous 10 of these evenings AND be a regular attender at Mass.

Cathedral of St Barnabas - Diocesan Youth Singing Day; Since appointing Ellie Martin to the post of Youth Choir Director in September 2017 the Cathedral Music Department is developing the opportunities for young people to enjoy making music in the Cathedral itself. This February we are holding our first ever Diocesan Youth Singing Day for young children from age 8-18 to 'Come and Sing....Gospels!'. International Cafe – starting on 12th February. It will run every Monday 9 – 11 at Main Street Methodist Church on Carlton Hill. It is there to provide support to people who are new to the country and area and could do with some support and a chance to meet people, get to know the area and practise speaking English in a friendly setting. Volunteers are still needed to serve refreshments and be there to chat to those who come – there is a planning and training session on Monday 29th January, 9.30. Come along and help out – you will not be needed every week, so if you can give a bit of time, then come forward.

Hospitals – urgent message. If you have a relative or a friend go into QMC or City, please inform the Chaplaincy Department either directly, through ward staff or via your parish priest and **request a visit, specifically from a Catholic Chaplain.** You will then be able to receive Holy Communion or Sacrament of the Sick in hospital, go to Mass at QMC or receive a simple pastoral visit.
