Next weekend; After the work to move the Gas supply to the church, normal service should be resumed! Our usual schedule and location of Masses will be in place. Thank you to everyone for their flexibility and understanding as this awkward job was completed.

The garage has gone! A big 'thank you' to the group of parishioners who worked so hard to get the gas supply moved and the garage demolished. The moving of the gas was done by an official contractor but the demolition was many willing hands – working over two weekends. This has saved us as a parish thousands of pounds over the quotes we were given. This now clears the way for the work to start in the next month or two on the building of the extension to the side of the church to provide us with a wheelchair access toilet (with baby changing facilities) and a small meeting room with a window onto the main body of the church. This will provide a meeting space for small parish groups but also a place during services where children can go if they need a few moments 'time out' This room will be called the 'St Bernadette Room' and we have saved the pictures of St Bernadette from our old chapel. Big thanks to Tommy Deane for coordinating all the work on the garage and gas supply.

Ash Wednesday; we are nearly at the beginning of Lent. Masses with distribution of ashes for Wednesday 14th Feb will be; 2.15pm. Mass in Sacred Heart School – open to all parents, grandparents, parishioners. 7.00 Wednesday evening – Mass in Sacred Heart Church.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence – we are supposed to go without and use whatever we save to help others who have no choice but to go without every day.

Next Sunday – there will be a short talk at each Mass from a member of our Parish Finance Committee – we feedback each year on the state of our finances, but this is a diocesan wide appeal for more people to give money to the parish through Gift Aid or Standing Order. IT IS NOT A SECOND COLLECTION! But it's a chance for us all to think about how we support our parish into the future.

St Bernadette's altar; last weekend, Fr Joe attended the official opening of AW Lymns new funeral home in Carlton – just down the hill. In one of the Chapels of Rest, the old stone and marble altar from St Bernadette's has been installed and above it a beautiful carving of Mary holding the infant Jesus. AW Lymns took the altar away nearly a year ago, gave us a donation and after cleaning it up, they have used it to provide a Christian focus for families coming to view the deceased. We had a lovely prayer of blessing of the altar as part of the official opening. There is an open invitation to anyone who wants to look round the new premises – just pop along. Mark and the staff would be very happy to show you round.

Sunday 11th February – Feast of our Lady of Lourdes. We will have a service of Blessing and Anointing of the Sick in the afternoon at 3.30. This is a very beautiful Sacrament that is for anyone who is ill, elderly, anxious it is NOT the Last Rites as many people who receive this Sacrament live for a good time afterwards!
