**1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion Parents meeting** – Thursday 6 – 7. Children in the small room with catechists, parents in the main hall. Please note – in order for parents to focus on the meeting and the discussions, it would be better if arrangements were made for children not on the programme not to come along. The parents meetings are important so that you are supported in helping your child grow in faith and understanding – they are as important as the group sessions with catechists.

**Building work;** You will have noticed that work has started on the extension to the church which will provide us with a disabled access toilet and small room for use during Mass. If you need flat access into the church, please pull up onto the slope in front of the building site, and then after the person who needs step free access has made their way into church move your car round into the car park. PLEASE DO NOT leave cars on this slope during Mass as it will prevent others accessing the church. Thank you.

**The Dog House** is now vacated. We are getting quotes for a demolition asbestos survey and for the actual demolition itself. This will be done before the summer and the site made good. There will be some inconvenience during the works, but they will be carried out so that the car park can be used safely.

**Sale of the presbytery and old church.** A 'for sale' board has gone up and it is on the market for offers around £275,000. We have two interested parties and the sale is being managed by FHP who did the sale of St Bernadette's for us.

**Stations of the Resurrection;** beautiful images and reflections for Easter have been created and written by our group of young people who met last Monday evening (CatholicTwentyFourSeven) These will hang in the church until Pentecost as a way of us praying and reflecting on the resurrection.

**Baptism preparation.** The next preparation course for parents is on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> April and Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> May, 7 – 8.30 each evening. It is the expectation that both parents attend both evenings. The first will be held at Our Lady & St Edwards on Gordon Road and the second at Sacred Heart. If you want to enrol on the course, take one of the forms from the back of church and return it completed to the parish office or Fr Joe.

**Rosary on the Coast - Sunday 29th April 2018:** the Parish of Grimsby, Cleethorpes & Immingham would like to invite you to Rosary on the Coast. There will be Holy Hour in Corpus Christi Church, Cleethorpes DN35 7LJ from 1.30 pm, concluding with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. At 2.30 pm, we will walk from the church to the Pier Gardens, overlooking the beach, to recite the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary at 3.00 pm, joining with Christians from across Wales, England & Scotland in praying for faith, life & peace in our countries.
