There will be a chance for him to introduce himself when he arrives in the summer.

Fr Eamon; As you will be aware, Fr Eamon left us this past week to go and live in Nazareth House in Sligo. This was arranged by his family and it is sad that we found out by chance and with little notice. At least some of us were able to say goodbye to him and gather for a photo after the 10.30 Mass. This is in the process of being framed and we will send it across to him as soon as we can. If you have any cards or anything (light!) you would like to send to Fr Eamon, get them into the presbytery in the next week or so and we can make up a parcel of everything for him. You can, of course, send him cards directly. His new address is Nazareth Nursing Home, Church Hill, Sligo, Ireland.

Presbytery and Old Church; You will know that for the past couple of months, there has been a 'for sale' sign up and the presbytery and old church have been on the market.

There has been lots of interest and we have recently accepted a full asking price offer from the Sisters of St Joseph of Peace who want to establish a new convent in our parish. We have been negotiating with them for several months and working with them to make the deal work.

There is all the usual legal stuff to go through and the Sisters will need to have a bit of work done on the building, but in the next few months, it will become a home initially for two Sisters and they will also be offering temporary accommodation for women left destitute by the asylum system. The old church will also be used to house their congregations archives and as office space. The Sisters of St Joseph of Peace were founded in Nottingham in 1884 by Mother Mary Cusack and now work across the world in education and for justice and peace. Needless to say, their presence will be a great blessing for the parish and it means that the presbytery and old church will in a sense 'remain in the family'. We could not ask for better neighbours.
