Church restoration; on Tuesday 7th May, the painters move in to begin the stripping of the columns and painting of the church. This means that there will be no access to Sacred Heart Church during the week, but we will have it back for the weekends. During this period of 8 – 10 weeks, weekday Masses will be in the Parish Centre each morning. At weekends, a small area at the back of church will be cordoned off for storage of scaffolding tower etc – please keep away from this area and supervise children at all times. **We are tentatively planning to have two Open Days** for local people to come and see the restored interior – on the 18th and 19th July, culminating with a service of re-dedication on the Friday evening.

As we go to print, final preparations are under way for Sr Katrina's Final Profession Mass this weekend. A big thank you to everyone who has worked hard in the preparation and we will continue to pray for Sr Katrina as she embarks on her fully-professed religious life. You will see that St Joseph's Convent is now fully scaffolded out, ready for work to begin prior to the sisters moving in.

Parish Centre Building project; we are still waiting for a response from Gedling Borough Council to our request for pre-planning advice. We should have this response by the 1st May. This will enable us to move onto the Planning Application. In the meantime, the Quantity Surveyor firm is working on a detailed costing for the project to ensure that we have a building that we can afford. On that note, in the past 6 months, we have done well with our fundraising..... Our projected costs started by showing a £80k shortfall – this is now halved..... we will now be looking in to grants for the build and continuing with our fundraising.
